Program Notes

Every magical journey begins with a wish made from the heart; a dream. A young girl who dreams of an adventure like the ones she reads in her book, to the boy who dreams to find love with a girl whose heart runs free. For those who are kind, brave, and have a creative spirit within them, a fairy godmother awaits to help make their dreams come true!

A tale as old as time. We all know the story of the kind hearted girl and her wicked step family who has the chance to live out her dreams, but only until midnight. This story has existed as far back as 7BC as an oral folk tale, before later being put to writing in 1697 with "Cendrillon" in 1697. The story would then become "Aschenputtel" in the Grimm Brothers Fairy Tales in 1812, the version of the story many of us are familiar with. From there, this story will go on to become the iconic Disney movie we all know and love, and has since gone on to spawn many more adaptations.

Raleigh Little Theatre decided to present their own spin on the classic tale 40 years ago, and this beloved story has now become a tradition within the theatre and the greater Raleigh community. For the last 40 years, Raleigh Little Theatre has been spreading the joy of *Cinderella* to their audiences, drawing in folks every year to celebrate the holiday season with their community. What is it about *Cinderella* that has continued to draw crowds for all these years?

It is not often you see a character whose greatest strength comes from their kindness. Cinderella is able to inspire audiences with her kind heart and resilience, rising above the problems she faces with patience and generosity. No matter the challenge, Cinderella faces it head on through showing kindness to all and having faith in her heart to guide her through life. It's Cinderella's ability to be loving and selfless to others that makes an impact not only on the Fairy Godmother, but on all those who have seen her story. Kids and adults alike can look to Cinderella as a role model for how we can be gracious and helpful to one another to create a better world where we build each other up instead of tearing each other down. Cinderella teaches audiences that kindness is a strength and having a good heart will always take you farther than selfishness ever could.

Raleigh Little Theatre's adaptation adds on to these qualities by shining a light on Cinderella's imagination.
