

PROGRAM NOTES

By Rayden Leeder, Dramaturg

From the trials of Salem to Sabrina Spellman, the topic of witches has kept a strong hold on the cultural zeitgeist. We are continually captivated by the idea of magic within our world, and it has led to the creation of many incredible works of art. Jen Silverman's *Witch* is another wonderful story surrounding the mystical and magical in a refreshingly grounded way.



The concept of witches stretches all the way back to biblical times, with some of the earliest mentions of witches coming from the books of Samuel and Exodus. It wasn't until the mass hysteria that hit Europe in the 1400s that witches took on a new life and identity of their own. Over the next 200 years, more than 80,000 women would be executed due to witchcraft accusations. Europeans were quick to accuse any woman they suspected to be working with the devil, tearing entire communities apart due to the mistrust of one another. The mistrust

and fear of witches within their communities led Europeans to create anti-witch propaganda, often in the form of pamphlets. These pamphlets existed to report on all things witches, from how to identify them in your own community to reports on the trials happening in the area. One such pamphlet, *The wonderfull discoverie of Elizabeth Sawyer, a witch late of Edmonton, her conviction and condemnation and death*, written by Henry Goodcole in 1621, inspired the play *The Witch of Edmonton* by William Rowley, Thomas Dekker and John Ford. Both the pamphlet and subsequent play are based on the real-life story of Elizabeth Sawyer, who was executed for witchcraft on April 19, 1621.

To be a witch was a concept now tainted with the negative perception that you were a bitter and manipulative temptress who lures innocents to devil worship. What made *The Witch of Edmonton* so unique in

comparison to the information on witches being represented during this time is how it was set up to make audiences empathize with the witch in the story. Instead of showing a wicked witch terrorizing an innocent town, the play gives us a normal woman who was pushed into becoming a witch due to the treatment she faced from her community. The idea of witches being women who turned to the devil

not because they were evil, but because the devil treated her with more kindness than the society she lived in was a new and subversive take for a story about witches. This concept would inspire Jen Silverman to write her own take on a modern witch story.

Witch by Jen Silverman takes a similar approach as *The Witch of Edmonton*, allowing us a glimpse into witch hysteria from the perspective of a misunderstood woman. Elizabeth is a normal woman who is reviled by her community, and the devil sees her as the perfect target due to her status. Despite the mistreatment Elizabeth faces, she is not so easily turned to the devil's side.

A story with stakes as high as fighting for inheritance, legacies, and titles, mixed with deals with a devil, *Witch* is, at its core, a story of love and connection. It brings to the fore ideas of transformation, love as a radical

act, and freedom from systematic power structures, themes found throughout many of Silverman's plays. Witch spins an incredibly complicated yet beautiful picture, showcasing that to be loved is to be seen, and the act of finding connection in a world where you feel invisible can forever change your outlook on life and the moments that define who you are.


