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Letter from the Director

My first show in town was right here at RLT going on 30 years ago. This place taught me what community could be. RLT raised me up when I wasn't perfect. RLT raised me up when it wasn't perfect. I believe to my core that this organization is always striving to support its community. So it makes perfect sense that RLT is producing *Kinky Boots* now.

I originally said Yes to this project in December of 2022. One of the things that excited me the most about an RLT *Kinky Boots* was that it immediately gave us the opportunity to strip away preconceived conventions audiences may carry in with them based on the Original Broadway and National Touring or Regional productions. It provided us the ability to truly create, from scratch, a production that reflects, amplifies, and celebrates the diverse community in which we live. With her first album, "She's So Unusual", Lauper won a Grammy Award for Best New Artist and became the first female in history to have four top-five singles from a debut album. Since then, Lauper has released ten additional studio albums, been inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame and celebrated as a New York Times best-selling author. Overall, during her storied music career, Lauper has been nominated for 15 Grammy Awards, two American Music Awards, seven American Video Awards and 18 MTV Awards. In 2013, Cyndi Lauper became the first solo woman to win Best original score for her music and lyrics for Kinky Boots. Never one to slow down, next she is currently writing the score for the Broadway adaptation of the 1988 feature film Working Girl, contributed a song to the score of the Broadway musical Spongebob Squarepants and launched her own fashion line A Touch of Cyn with Home Shopping Network.

TIM MALBOEUF (Choreographer) is a Raleigh native actor, director, choreographer and educator. BFA Musical Theatre graduate of Emerson College.
